#### Notes for Crews from Overseas

##### Entries

Henley Royal Regatta (HRR) no longer sends out paper copies of the Official Entry Form to National Federations and Clubs.

From 14 June 2021, Overseas Clubs will be able to download an Entry Form and associated guidance notes at [regattaentries.co.uk](http://regattaentries.co.uk)

Payment for all entries must be made online at [regattaentries.co.uk/pay](http://regattaentries.co.uk/pay) and the receipt must be attached to your completed Entry Form before sending it to be counter-signed by a representative of your National Federation.

The National Federation must then scan the Entry Form into PDF format and email the Entry Form to [entries@hrr.co.uk](mailto:entries@hrr.co.uk) to arrive before the Closing Date for entries – 14:00 (British Summer Time) on Monday, 19 July 2021.

##### Accommodation

Unfortunately, due to the ongoing COVID situation, HRR is not in a position to provide a service matching Overseas crews to accommodation in the Henley area. However, a list of households that are prepared to put up crews in Henley will shortly be available to download from [regattaentries.co.uk](http://regattaentries.co.uk) but it is likely that less accommodation will be available this year.

##### Transport

The Regatta is unable to assist crews with transport arrangements. If you want to hire a minibus, you are strongly advised to deal with one of the many vehicle hire operators working out of Heathrow Airport. It is almost impossible to hire minibuses in Henley.

##### Boats and Oars

Ordinarily, if you want to hire boats and oars, Andy Crawford would help to make an introduction for you with UK Clubs. HRR does not get involved in the hire process - Andy simply acts as a link to put people in touch – we take no responsibility!

Under the current COVID restrictions we have no indication as to the appetite for UK Clubs to hire equipment out but Andy is happy to be contacted by email at [boats@hrr.co.uk](mailto:boats@hrr.co.uk)

All racing boats competing at the Regatta are required by the Environment Agency (the Navigation Authority) to have a Licence. However, it is likely that the majority of UK boats available for hire will already have a Licence. A limited number of Licences (£10) will be available from the Boating area on arrival in Henley.

### **Overseas Competitor Badges**

In a normal year, the purchase of Overseas Competitor Badges allow competitors to access the prestigious Stewards' Enclosure.

Unfortunately, under the COVID restrictions envisaged at the moment, the Competitor area will be moved to the other side of the river and, unless the restrictions ease considerably, competitors will not be able to enter the Stewards' Enclosure.

Solely as a souvenir, the coach of an overseas crew is allowed to purchase Overseas Competitor Badges and they will cost £50 each.

### **Overseas Visitors - Stewards' Enclosure Guest Badges**

Similarly, in a normal year the Coach of an Overseas crew is also able to purchase Stewards' Enclosure Guest Badges for supporters of their crew. Unfortunately, for the reasons outlined above, supporters will not be able to enter the Stewards' Enclosure this year.

If restrictions ease considerably, the crew coach will be contacted by email.
